## Bite into the fresh food scene

From prawns hauled straight off the boat to ripe mangoes sourced from the Atherton Tablelands, Cairns' food scene puts locallysourced ingredients front and centre. Open Friday to Sunday, Rusty's Markets captivates with more than 180 stalls showcasing the best tropical produce of the



region. Wander through rows showcasing avocado, pineapples, bananas and dragonfruit or find gourmet stalls offering  $everything\, from\, made-to-order\, crepes\, to$ cold-pressed juices, Korean-style chicken and Italian savoury pastries.

Do as locals do and celebrate your market haul with breakfast at a hip cafe on Grafton Street or grab an espresso from Blackbird, tucked away in Oceana Walk.

For something a little quirkier, take a seat in an old fishing trawler repurposed as a much-loved seafood eatery. Prawn Star, docked at Cairns' marina, serves local mud crab, oysters and prawns in a relaxed, oneof-a-kind atmosphere.

If fine dining is more your thing, book a table at award-winning Tamarind Restaurant, where dishes such as whole crispy baby barramundi and fragrant teasmoked quail offer complex flavours for sophisticated palates.

After dark, wander down a laneway to imbibe at Cairns' newest late-night haunt, Three Wolves.

Smooth cocktails, craft ales, moreish bar bites and seriously good bar staff bring small bar culture to Cairns in an exclusive spot away from other bars and restaurants.

Whether you're after a tropical beach break minus the jetlag or a fun weekend escape in the sun, Cairns is the answer.
